Echinacea Catharina is a stunning double flowered variety with vivid neon pink blooms. Catharina is medium sized variety that grows to approximately 30” in the garden. Catharina has very stiff stems making it a great cut flower. In cooler temperatures a distinct green center appears in the flower making for a great contrast. Catharina is a showstopper and will look great as a focal point in the garden.
